	As per the Central Water Commission (CWC), it is estimated that 11 out of 15 river basins in India will experience water stress by 2025, with annual per









capita renewable water availability below 1700 cubic metres. Hence, it becomes imperative to explore alternate source of water especially for irrigation. Reclaimed water from industry and urban areas has tremendous potential and is the best possible and stable resource available which can even save fertilizer costs. The session will debate around how industries can take the lead in securing a sustainable water future for Indian agriculture encompassing various aspects including water reclamation, revolutionizing irrigation practices, ultimately contributing to a more water-secure and environmentally friendly agricultural landscape in India.
